PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS FOR LOKA INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL 2025

i. Activity Info

Loka Short Film Festival is a program that organizes a short video creation competition based on a specified theme. The competition is divided into two categories: The Higher Education Institution (HEI) Category and the Open Category.

ii. Competition Requirements for the Higher Education Institution (HEI) Category

- a. Participation fee is RM20.
- b. Open to Malaysian citizens and active students from all public and private universities (IPTA/IPTS) and PolyCC in Malaysia.
- c. Non-Malaysian students are not allowed to participate in the HEI category, instead they must register under the Open category.
- d. All participants must use the official PolyCC logo provided.
- e. The short video concept is open, with themes focusing on promoting PolyCC TVET or Perlis tourism.
- f. The use of Bahasa Melayu or English is prioritized; however, if other languages are used, subtitles in Bahasa Melayu or English must be included.
- g. Submissions must not contain elements of crime, sexuality, or sensitive issues that could disrupt racial, cultural, religious, and societal harmony in Malaysia. All content must comply with Malaysian laws and the *Lembaga Penapisan Filem (LPF)*.
- h. Entries must consist of the participant's original work and must include self-recorded video footage.
- i. Entries Video must not have previously won any national or international video competitions.
- j. Participants are encouraged to use original music scores. If using commercially available tracks or others' copyrighted music, participants must obtain written permission from the relevant party. The organizers are not responsible for any copyright infringement claims.
- k. Entries will be disqualified if found to be plagiarized or not original.
- I. The organizer reserves the right to use submitted works for promotional and related purposes.
- m. Video duration must be a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes.
- n. Submission period is from 1 January 2025 to disqualified.

iii. Competition Requirements for the Open Category (Malaysia/International)

- a. Participation fee is RM100 for Malaysian citizens.
- b. Participation fee is RM180 for non-citizens/international participants/international student.
- c. Open to both Malaysian and non-Malaysian participants.
- d. The short film concept is open, with the theme "Our Film, Our World."
- e. The use of Bahasa Melayu or English is prioritized; however, if other languages are used, subtitles in Bahasa Melayu or English must be included.
- f. Submissions must not contain elements of crime, sexuality, or sensitive issues that could disrupt racial, cultural, religious, and societal harmony in Malaysia. All content must comply with Malaysian laws and the *Lembaga Penapisan Filem (LPF)*.
- g. Entries must consist of the participant's original work and must include self-recorded video footage.
- h. Entries Short Film must not have previously won any national or international video competitions.
- i. Participants are encouraged to use original music scores. If using commercially available tracks or others' copyrighted music, participants must obtain written permission from the relevant party. The organizers are not responsible for any copyright infringement claims.
- j. Entries will be disqualified if found to be plagiarized or not original.
- k. The organizer reserves the right to use submitted works for promotional and related purposes.
- I. Video duration must be a minimum of ten (10) minutes and a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes
- m. Submission period is from **1 January 2025** to **31 January 2025**. Late submissions will be disqualified.

- c. Winners will be announced during the TVET POLYCC 2025 Carnival Day on 15 February 2025, at the Mahsuri International Exhibition Centre (MIEC) in Langkawi.

vii. Video Specifications

- a. Video Duration including intro and credits.
 - HEI Student Category: Minimum 3 minutes Maximum 5 minutes.
 - Open Category: Minimum 10 minutes Maximum 15 minutes.
- b. Accepted format: MOV, MPEG4, MP4, AVI atau MPEG-PS.
- c. Minimum resolution: 1080p (1920 × 1080) or higher, with a video aspect ratio of 16:9 only.
- d. Participants may create videos in Bahasa Melayu or English.
- e. The video must feature high-quality visuals and clear audio.
- f. The use of special effects is allowed, based on the creativity of each team.
